


Piano Duet Senior Student Concert Sunday, May 2, 3:00-4:00 p.m. Bascomb UMC Sanctuary



April 18 — 3rd Sunday of Easter Sermon Title: "The Author of Life'" Scripture: Acts 3:12-19 (CEB)

Who is your favorite author? Hard to say sometimes when there's such a variety of literature, but let's focus on story - factual (like a biography) or fictional (like a novel or short story). We are spending many Sundays in Eastertide in Luke's "Part II" gospel: Acts and Peter is the early protagonist of this story. Peter describes Jesus as "the Author of LIFE." Wow! Jesus could be understood as the author of each of OUR stories - right? I guess the challenge is... NOT to overwrite the Author! We may call Acts a product of Luke's authorship, but GOD is the true author of all scripture and Jesus is declared to be the "Author of Life." How can we best understand that? How do we live into our BEST story, our highest calling? Do we really think it's a good idea to overwrite God's story? Come this Sunday and let us see what we can discover.





We have been through a lot this year – and still have some challenges to go. As we continue our journey forward, we affirm Christ is risen indeed, and He lives today.

On Thursday mornings at 10:00, April 22 – May 27, we will be studying *You are Never Alone: Trust in the Miracle of God's Presence and Power* by Max Lucado. This six-session study is based on the Gospel of John, exploring the account of Christ's miracles and how He's still at work in our lives today. We will meet in the Fellowship Hall, with all Covid precautions in place.
