

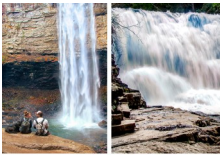

**THE SECOND HALF**

April 25 — 4<sup>th</sup> Sunday of Easter

Sermon Title: "The Second Half"

Scripture: 1 John 3:16-24 (CEB)
