August 1 — 10th Sunday after Pentecost Sermon Title: "Forced Into It" Scripture: John 6:14-21

It seems the word **authority** is a political term. Who has the power – does might always make right? Are there other ways we acknowledge authority? Like, do WE (the people) grant persons authority over us? Can a person EARN authority through study (Doctor of Medicine or doctorate in science)? Max Weber (sociologist and philosopher) is famous for his description of three types of power: charismatic (a massive trust and unbreakable faith people grant to a person), traditional (the prevailing order in society - males or fathers, senior classmates on campus, in some cultures – their elders), and legal-rational (grounded in clearly defined laws the rank, position, or office a person holds). Where is Jesus in your understanding of authority? The text says they would "force him to be their king." Forcing Jesus, forcing God, forcing others - how's that working out? Come, let us reason together at God's banquet table (now "in-person" only).
