Sermon Title: "Wisdom as a Woman"

Scripture: Proverbs 1:20-25, 31:25-26, 29-30

Wisdom personified as a woman is a wonderful Jewish salute to the "feminine divine." God said: let US make humankind in our own image Genesis 1:26-27. God's creation requires both male and female – they are vital to creation as we come to express the physical world. But has our culture embraced the full advantages of the feminine influence? Women have always found ways to influence society, but what does it look like?

Proverbs was an early expression of how to live God's "good life." Again, the beginning of wisdom is "RESPECT" for the one creating. Those of us seeking to embrace God's "good life" should keep calling to the rest of humanity wandering out there in darkness. How confident are we of OUR position? How do we fulfill God's best, God's highest calling as males and females? Is our expression of God's best convincing, attractive to those watching us as we point toward God's "best life?"
