Sermon Title: "Copycat" Scripture: Philippians 3:12-17 (CEB)

Copycat is a pejorative term – a negative "cut" on your personality that you can't be original so you must copy someone else. That's not always true. Jimmy Fallon is famous for his "mirror" sketches. He sits at a fake mirror pretending to be the actual person sitting on the other side. Imitation is the highest form of flattery. This Sunday we will examine some telling details of Paul's letter to the Philippians. Paul sets himself up as an example. He declares himself to be "an imitator of Christ." What a bold claim! How dare he? How about you? Are you one of those who could dare to say, "look at my example – I'm an imitator of Christ!" Would we dare?
