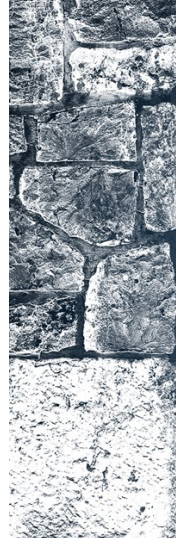

Psalm 118:1-2, 19-29

April 10 — Palm / Passion Sunday

Sermon Title: "Rejected"

Scripture: Psalm 118:1-2, 19-29

This Psalm declares that a "rejected stone" had become the cornerstone of our faith! Before we jump with both feet into our Christian interpretation on this text, just limit yourself to the text alone. The psalmist was not a Christian, but a Jew. So, what was this poet thinking? To whom was the message intended? We should always look at the original context as the launching pad for a full understanding. The text does indeed point to Jesus from our perspective, no doubt. But what we make of the text must never contradict the author's original meaning. So, let's go there first! Just who or what is rejected here?
