
October 2 — World Communion Sunday Sermon Title: "The Good Treasure" Scripture: 2 Timothy 1:6-14

My first introduction to the United Methodist Church took place when I was invited several times to a MYF group in Smyrna as a youth. I always liked going to MYF because there were some great memories made there over the years. It was during this fellowship time that I was first introduced to this idea of having a relationship with Jesus Christ.

I would like to give you a little homework for this coming Sunday's sermon. I want you to look back over your life and see what some of your favorite church memories were? Think about those memories and be ready to think long and hard on Sunday when I ask those questions.

In our scripture reading for this week, the Apostle Paul wanted his student and fellow believer, Timothy, to remember all that Paul had taught and given to his young pupil, Timothy. Paul shared that with Timothy because he believed that his earthly time would end and that Timothy would need to be ready for the Holy Spirit to guide him through the churches he would establish and to "guard the good treasure" that had been entrusted to Timothy over his years with Paul.
