April 23—Second Sunday after Easter *“Don’t Be an Eeyore”* - Luke 24: 13-35

Have you ever had a case of “spiritual heartburn?” In our reading for this coming Sunday, we will look at a case of “spiritual heartburn” which can be found in Luke 24:13-35?

So, what does spiritual heartburn look like? I believe that in most cases, it takes place where we have experienced and/or were taught certain spiritual truth(s) in the past from our lives. Then somewhere later in our lives, we forget about those spiritual truths and the impact they may have had in our spiritual walk.

Then sometime later on in our lives, we encounter one or more of those same spiritual truths, and we struggle with those truths. Even though they may not sound familiar or relevant at the time, we sense that within our self, there is something more about the truth that speaks to us and most times we can’t even stop thinking about them.

What are some of those spiritual truths from your past that may not be a part of our spiritual life, but somehow are still present in both your mind and soul. Think about them. Pray about them. Seek God’s Spirit to help you recover and remember the truths of your past which may help you once again grow and energize your walk with Christ and the world around you.
