John 17:20-21

20. I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message.

May 21—

"Known By a Name" - John 17: 1-11

"My prayer is not for them alone. I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message, that all of them may be one, Father, just as you are in me and I am in you." —John 17:20-21a

Our reading for this Sunday, May 21st, is a bit different than our regular readings each week. It is not a detailed story of what was happening but was a detailed prayer that Jesus prayed for his disciples AND for you and me.

If you look closely at the verses above, you will notice Jesus praying for the disciples and "I pray also for those who will believe in me through their message." Think about that for a second. We believe in Jesus as the Son of God and as the Savior of the world because of the witness and faith of Jesus' original disciples. It was those same disciples who passed on the stories and teachings of Jesus to those places which the Holy Spirit took them to after Pentecost.

Now some 2,000 years later, it is those same stories and teachings of Jesus which are still bringing people today to come to their faith in Christ. And for the past 193 years, Bascomb Methodist have been sharing those same stories and teachings of Jesus faithfully to all who would come here on Sundays and any other day of the week when and where our Bible Studies would take place.

Who do you know that needs a place so they too can learn about the One who was the Son of God and the Savior of the world? Pray about inviting them to Bascomb and see where God works in their lives.
