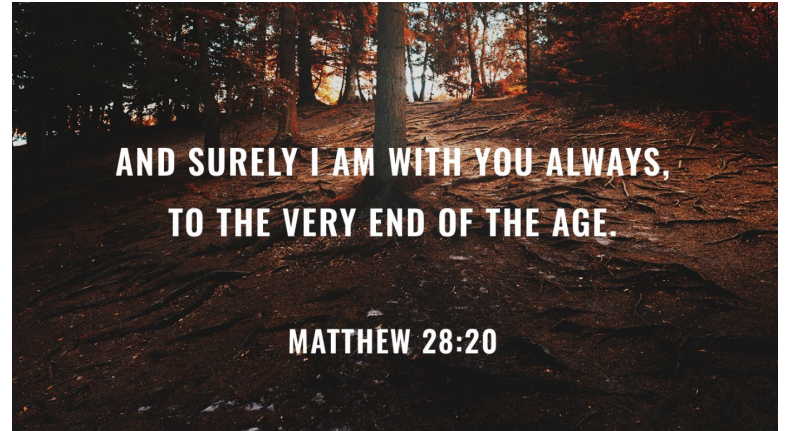

June 4—Holy Communion Sunday  
"Making Church a Verb" - Matthew 28: 16-20

*"Therefore, go and make disciples of all nations, baptizing them in the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit, and teaching them to obey everything I have commanded you. And surely, I am with you always, to the very end of the age."*

Matthew 28:19-20

Our Scripture reading for this Sunday is Matthew's account of what Jesus shared with the disciples before he ascended into heaven. During their time together on the mountain, Jesus gave them a commandment and a promise. His commandment to his disciples *and to us today*, is that we were to go and make disciples of all nations. And once we have made them a disciple, we are to baptize them in the name of our triune God, *"the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit."*

And once when they became disciples, they were to teach the new disciples everything that they had learned from Jesus. Of course, the question would be how would the disciples remember everything? By the power of the Holy Spirit; the Holy Spirit would help them to remember everything from Jesus' teachings to the miracles he performed.

Finally, Jesus offered the disciples a promise. He told them that he would always be with each of the disciples until the very end of the age which would be the time when Jesus returned for the final time. And that same promise is available for us today. Jesus is always with each of us. No matter where we are, Jesus is always with us wanting the best for us in every situation. Always has been and always will be. We just have to trust and to believe.
