Mark 3:20-35 "Out of His Mind"

Have you ever been told that you're out of your mind? Have you ever been told that you have no common sense? Have you ever been told that there is nothing spiritual about you?

If you answered 'yes' to any of the three questions above, then you have something in common with Jesus. And it is always a good thing when you have something in common with Jesus!!! The challenge for us is to get closer and closer to Jesus so that we will eventually end up as close to being 100 percent with him. Please notice I didn't say that we would be able to be equal to Jesus.

There are two reasons for that, and the first reason is obvious; Jesus is the Son of God and is completely blameless and without sin. The second reason is that humanity is <u>with sin</u>. Since the Garden of Eden, all of humanity has had sin in their life. Always has and always will until when Jesus comes back for the final time for the judgment of all of humanity.

Now there are some people in the world today who would have read the previous paragraph and told us that we were out of our mind and that we had no common sense at all. And they may have also told us that there was nothing spiritual about us too.

In our Scripture reading for Sunday, there were people who thought that Jesus was out of his mind, that he had no common sense, and that he had an impure spirit within him. Even some of Jesus' own family also thought he was "out of his mind." Even with Jesus living his life the way he did, he was still criticized and rebuked.

Have you ever wondered what would happen if you lived your life now like Jesus did? Would people appreciate what you were trying to do wherever you could? Would you be commended by some or to be committed by others telling you that you were out of your mind? That you had no common sense? Or, that there was nothing spiritual about you? What would you do?
