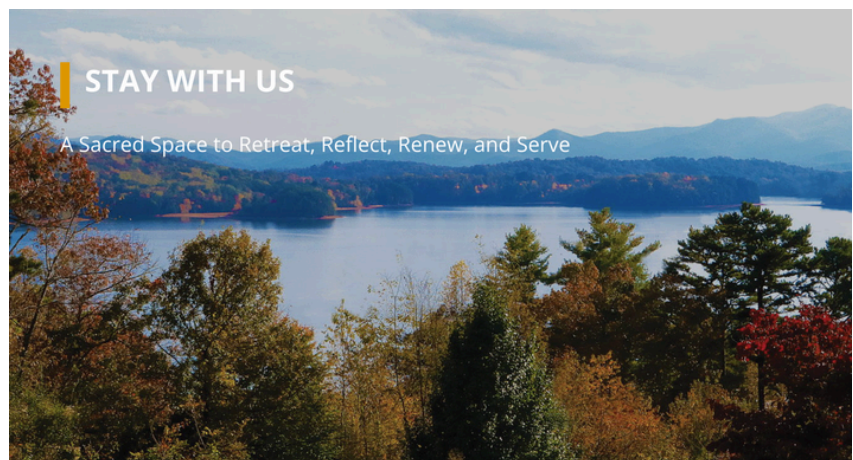


VBS - True North - July 14-18th
