From our Preschool Director, Kathi Underwood

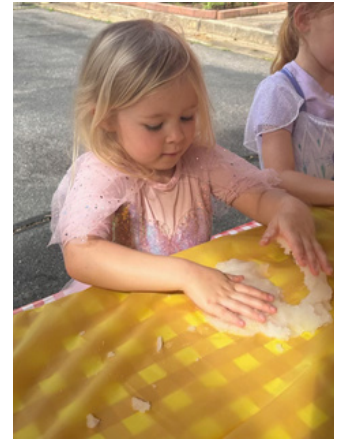
Preschool enjoyed three weeks of summer camp with our preschool families during the first part of June; we had around 45 participants each week and kept our staff busy! We learned about sea life with an aquarium theme and practiced our 'camping' skills during camp weeks one and two. We also celebrated our country in week three with a red, white and blue theme.

As of June 23rd, the preschool will be closed for classes, and staff members will clean and paint and get the school ready for the upcoming school year, which will start on August 1st for training and room preparation. Students will return on August 11th, and we will serve about 75 families, who will be invited to the Open House on Sunday, August 10th.

The preschool playground will be going into its 20th year as of August 2025, so BUMP will have to consider the life of the equipment and a big improvement campaign for the playground, fence and grounds.

We are welcoming some new faces at the preschool and also have most of the staff returning for 2025-2026. We have 18 staff members, and we ask for your prayers and support as we continue this ministry that is now 40 years old!!

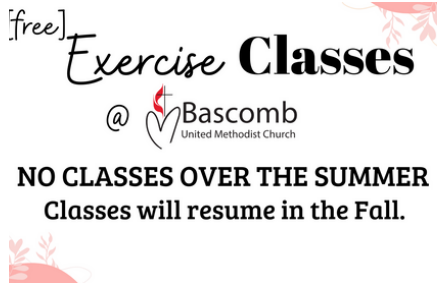

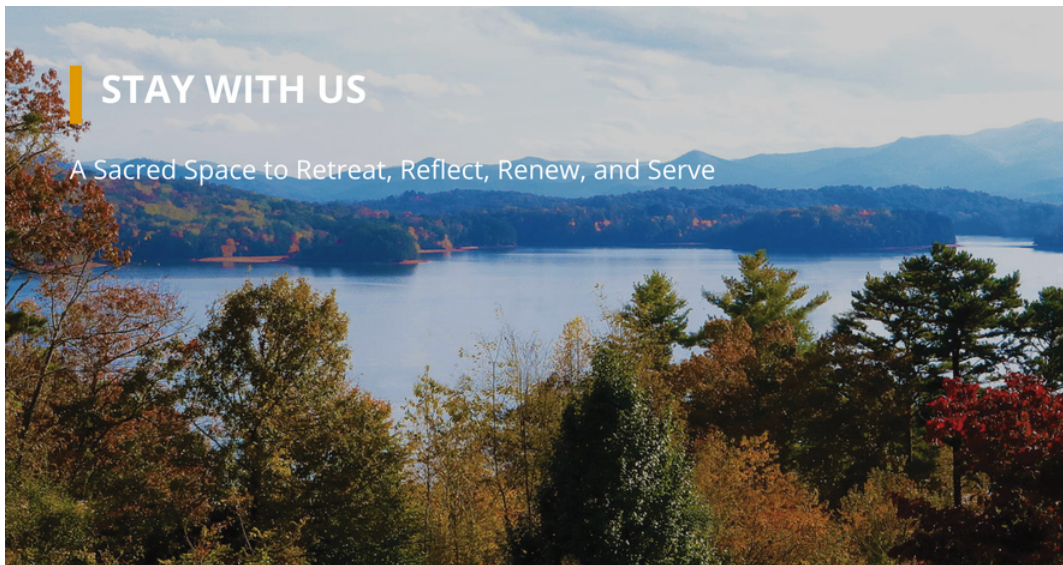
