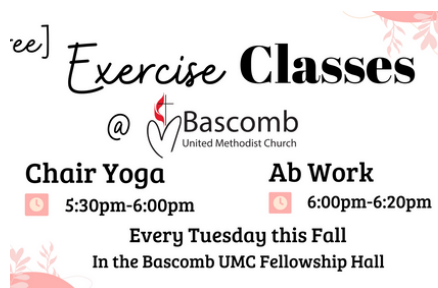

Experience the story of Jesus' birth come to life with two showings — one at 6:00 PM and another at 7:00 PM.

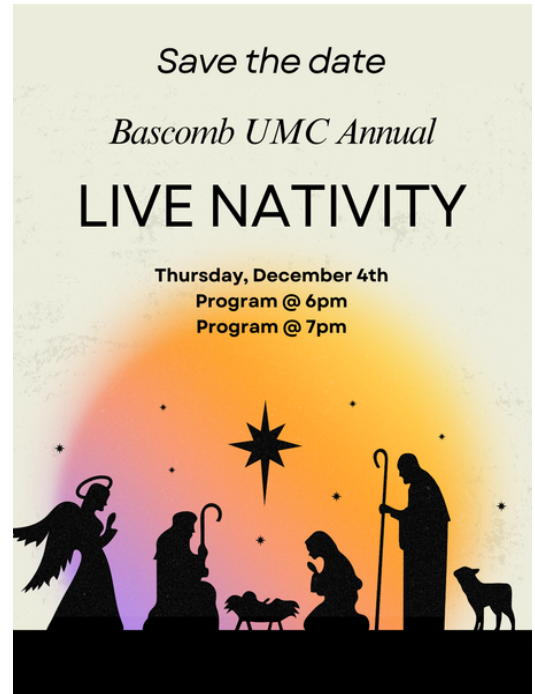
Enjoy a night full of family fun and festive treats, including:
